The Department of Spanish Philology and the Department of Department of Spanish Language and Literature Teaching at the University of Valencia are pleased to announce the 13th International Conference of the Spanish Society of Linguistic Historiography (Sociedad Española de Historiografía Lingüística, SEHL), which will take place at the University of Valencia (Valencia, Spain) from the 27th to the 30th of April 2021.

The Spanish Society of Linguistic Historiography came to begin in 1995, aiming to promote and disseminate the study of the History of Language Sciences through the epistemological evolution of its different subjects, with special attention to in the Hispanic world. Since then, the Society has had a pivotal role in facilitating the academic dialogue between researchers interested in the field of Linguistic Historiography.

The continuous efforts of the Society to meet its aims have materialised in the past 25 years in twelve international conferences, held every two years: A Coruña (1997), León (1999), Vigo (2001), La Laguna (2003), Murcia (2005), Cádiz (2007), Vila-Real (2009), Madrid (2011), Córdoba (2013), Cáceres (2015), Buenos Aires (2017) and Forlì (2019). The Proceedings of these Conferences, together with the papers published in the bi-annual SEHL Bulletin, are considered essential works in the area of historiographical studies with contributions from researchers from national and international universities.

This 13th Conference will be an opportunity to celebrate the Society's 25th Anniversary and will represent an opportunity to reflect on the attainments achieved during this time, as well as on the challenges and potential new paths for the future of the discipline.

Submission guidelines for proposals

Each participant may submit a maximum of two papers. In the case of proposals with more than one author, all authors must register for the conference. The stipulated time for the oral presentation is 20 minutes, followed by 10 minutes to debate.

OPENING OF NEW DEADLINES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF PAPER PROPOSALS AND FOR REGISTRATION TO THE CONGRESS

Communications that have already been accepted will be maintained, if confirmed by those who have submitted them. For organizational reasons, a confirmation e-mail must be sent to the congress address (xiiicisehl2021@uv.es) by **1 June 2021**.

The deadline for the submission of new proposals is now open through the form available on the Congress website (<https://congresos.adeituv.es/XIIICISEHL2021/>). The deadline is **30 September 2021** at 23:59 hours.

The proposals will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee taking into account the scientific quality and originality of its content in the field of Linguistic Historiography. Both the oral presentation must be presented at least by one of the authors. Presentation by non-authors is not permitted.

Languages of the conference: Spanish, Catalan, Galician, Basque, English, French, Italian and Portuguese.
